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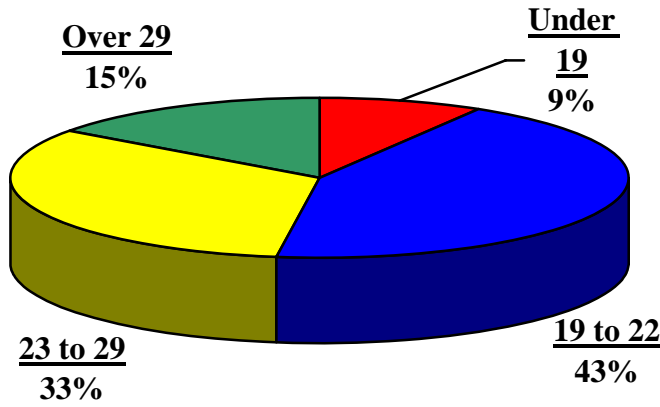

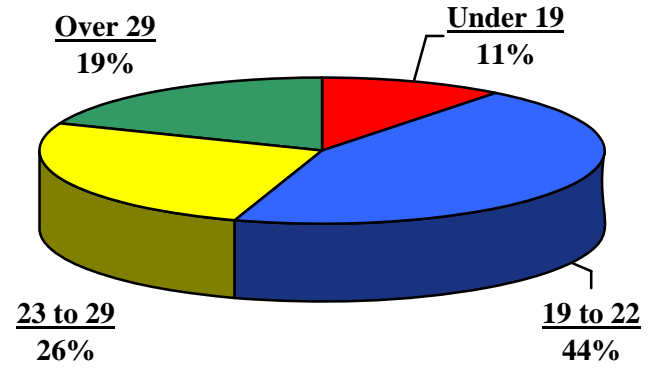
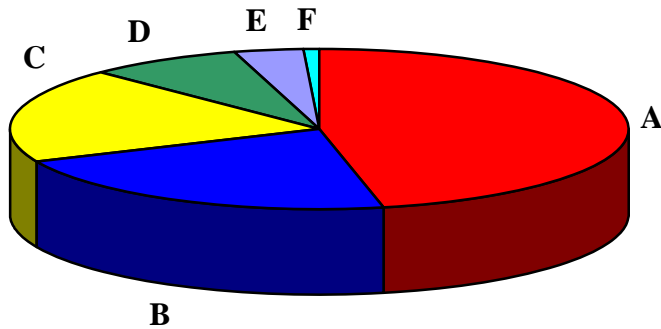


Figure 1 & 2 - Background Information, Age

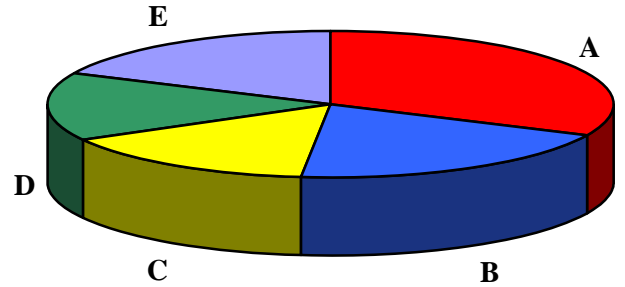
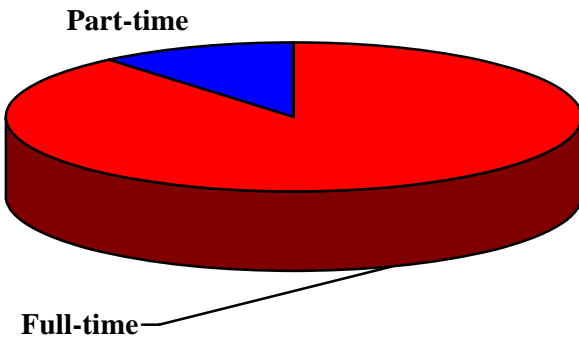


Figure3 & 4-Background Information, Classification

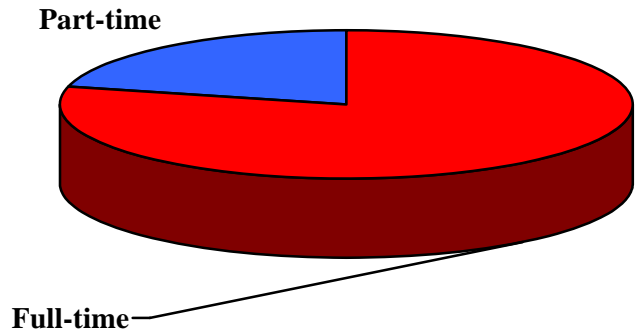
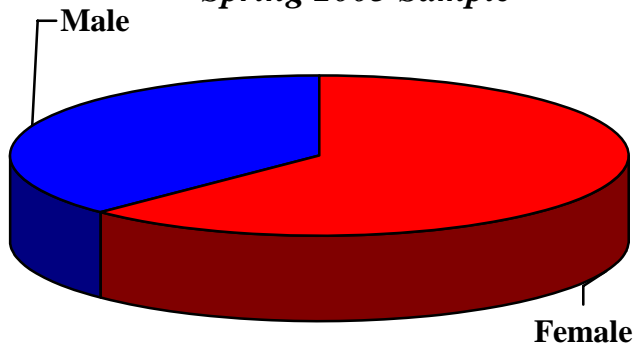


Figure5 & 6-Background Information, Enrollment Status

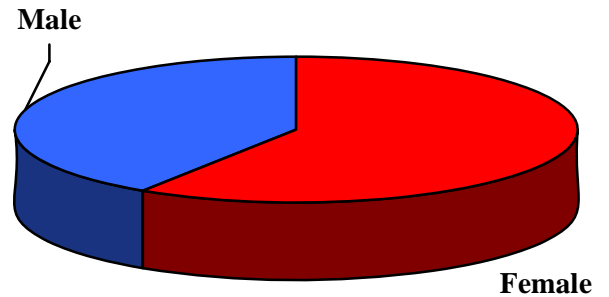
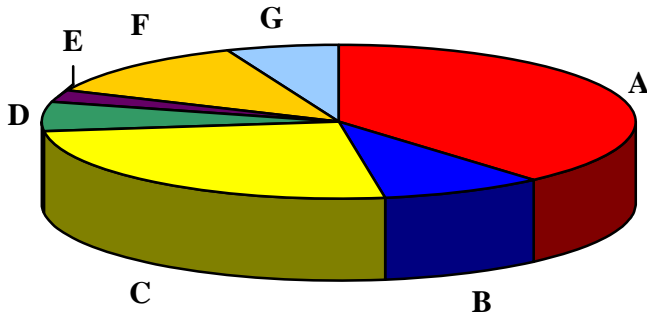


Figure7 & 8-Background Information, Gender

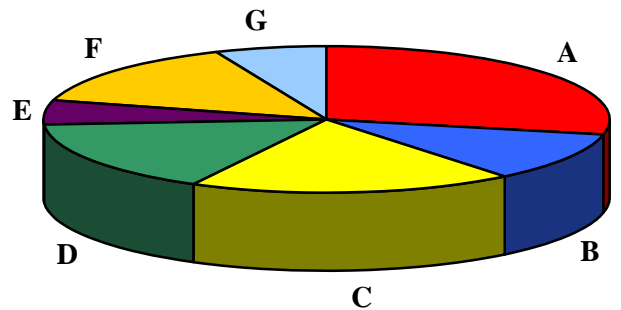
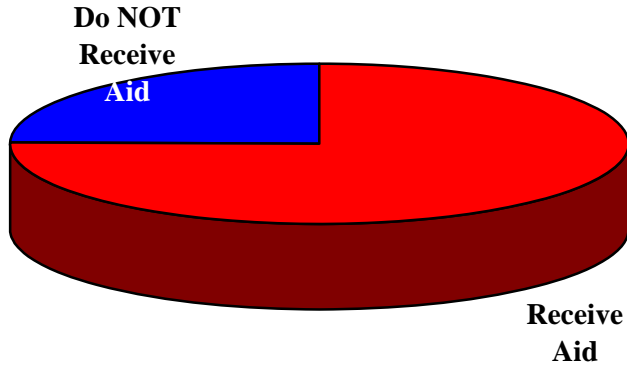


Figure 9& 10-Background Information, School or College

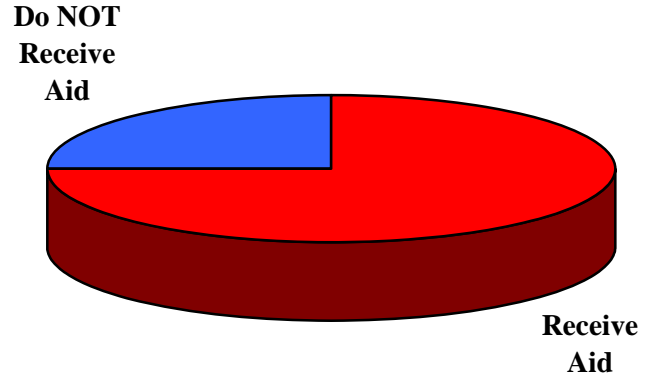


Figure 11& 12-Background Information, Age

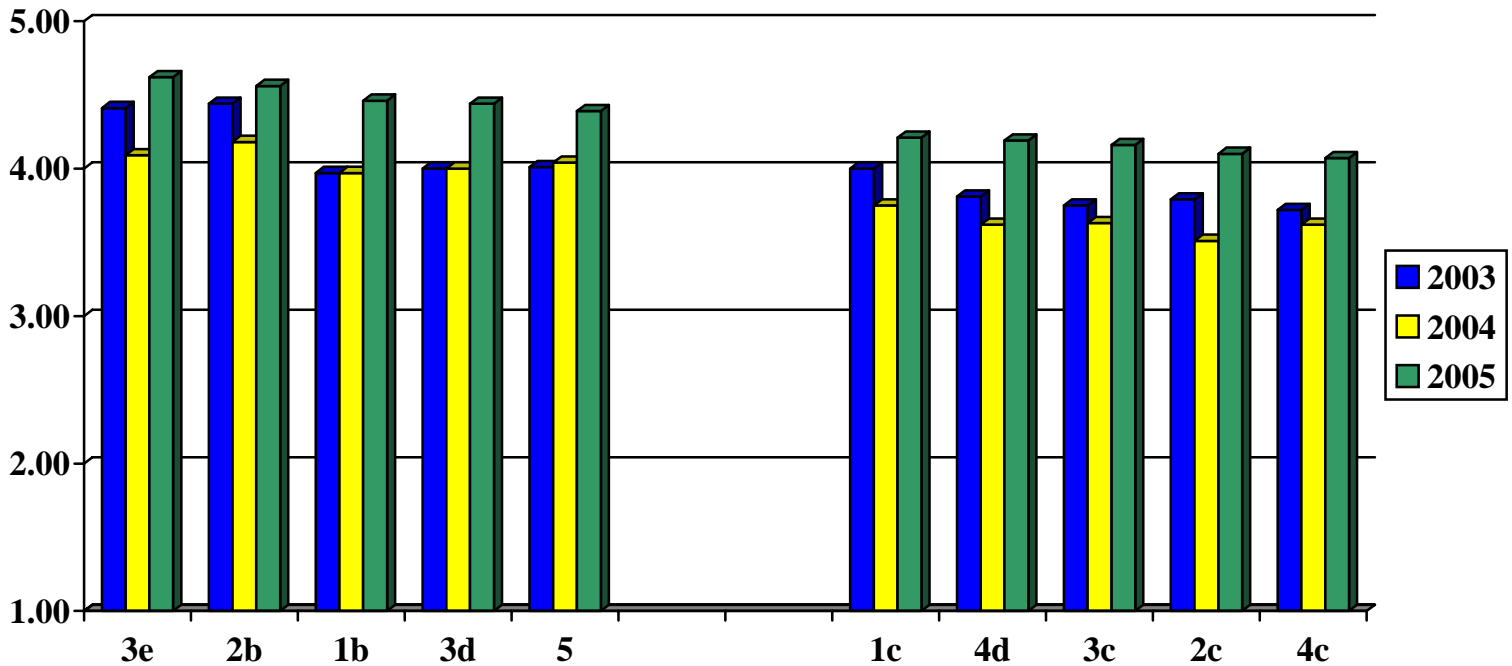


Figure13-Satisfaction with Registration Services and Registration Service Areas
