As a reminder, all students living in university housing are required to show proof of a negative test before move-in.

Free vaccinations are available to help protect individuals from the viral spread. COVID vaccines are available at the St. Luke's Health Vaccination Clinic in the Nabrit Science Building, Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.
