# **Opening**

The meeting of the Associate/Assistant Deans' Council was called to order at 3:00 p.m. by Associate Provost Brown-Guillory. She moved that the minutes from the previous meeting be approved. Dr. Michael Sollars moved to approve the minutes; it was seconded by Dr. Shishir Shishodia.

# A. Report from the Teaching and Learning Excellence Center (TLEC)

• Dr. Kimberly McLeod, Interim Director of TLEC, spoke to faculty about current faculty development opportunities offered through TLEC. Dr. McLeod also mentioned that Associate Brown-Guillory and an Ad hoc Committee are investigating procedures for dropping students from classes. Far too many students are receiving "F's" as if they are failing to perform satisfactorily when, in fact, they have stopped attending and are given an "F". Dr. McLeod said that if students are dropped due to a lack of attendance, this would aid the university in being more accurate in its state reporting.

# B. Address from Provost Ohia

- Dr. Sunny E. Ohia, Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs and Vice President for Research, spoke to the council about three areas of concern: enrollment management, better advising of students in declaring majors, about improving the mentoring process for tenure-track faculty.
- C. Report from the Office of Institutional Assessment, Planning and Effectiveness
  - Dr. Raijanel Crockem, Interim Executive Director, Institutional Assessment, Planning & Effectiveness, updated the council on her office's data request processes and the benefits of having a centralized process in place. Dr. Crockem congratulated faculty on having 90% of class syllabi and faculty curriculum vitas posted online within the time limit of seven days after the semester begins. She reminded the council that because her office does not own the data that it is imperative that what is sent in is as correct as possible. Dr. Crockem asked faculty to double check their data to make sure it is correct and to call her office to make any updates and changes. She also asked that all requests for data from departments be centralized and sent by one person to prevent duplication of requests.

# D. Document Collection and Signature Authority Protocols

• Dr. Fennoyee Thomas addressed the council concerning the signature process for deans, specifically concerning the class substitution form, and asked that the process be made easier to understand for students as well as faculty and administration. She suggested that the process be reevaluated and that the form be updated accordingly.

# Adjournment:

Dr. Maurice Mangum moved to adjourn the meeting, and it was seconded by Dr. Desirée Jackson. The meeting was adjourned at 4:00 pm. The next meeting of the Associate/Assistant Deans' Council is scheduled for Monday, April 22, 2013 at 3:00pm in the Hannah Hall Human Resources Conference Room 129.
