







Counties of In-State Students Fall 2010 to Fall 2014 Top 5 Counties Harris Dallas Fort Bend Tarrant Jefferson


Average Age Fall 2010 to Fall 2014 19 years old











SAT Scores






First-Semester Hours Attempted to Hours Completed Comparison






First-Semester GPA
