




Total Enrollment




Percent Change Over Prior Year











Counties of In-State Students Fall 2011 to Fall 2015 Top 5 Counties Harris Dallas Tarrant Fort Bend Brazoria





First-Generation Status






ACT Scores








SAT Scores




First-Semester Hours Attempted to Hours Completed Comparison








First-Semester GPA
