Figure 1: Number of Survey Respondents





Figure 2: Total Bachelor Degree Population & Percent of Respondents




Figure 4: Parent Graduated from College

Figure 5: Choose to Attend TSU Again at a Specific Classification Level





Figure 6: Plan to Attend Graduate School

Figure 8: Intend to Become A Member of TSU Alumni Association




Figure 9: Intend to Contribute Money to TSU
