


Figure1& 2-Background Information, Age




Figure3 & 4-Background Information, Classification




Figure 5 & 6-Background Information, Gender




Figure 7& 8-Background Information, School or College




Figure 9 & 10-Background Information, Type of School Attended Prior to Enrolling At TSU




Figure11-College Services: Satisfaction with College Services for Those Who Have Used This Service





Figure12- College Services Largest Positive & Largest Negative Differences between Spring '03 & '05 Sample Population Average Satisfaction Level with the Services of TSU




Figure14- College Environment Largest Positive & Largest Negative
