Educator Preparation Program (EPP) - CHECKLIST	
<input type="checkbox"/>	There is a potential for ineligibility of an individual who has been convicted of an offense for issuance of a certificate on completion of the EPP; Please review the current State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC) rules prescribed in §249.16 of this title (relating to Eligibility of Persons with Criminal History for a Certificate under Texas Occupations Code, Chapter 53, and Texas Education Code, Chapter 21); and You have the right to request a criminal history evaluation letter as provided in Chapter 227, Subchapter B, of this title (relating to Preliminary Evaluation of Certification Eligibility).

<input type="checkbox"/>	Completion of core requirements (42 hours) and those courses identified in your degree plan.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Apply for a Texas Education Agency (TEA) Login (TEAL) and a profile for Educator Certification Online System (ECOS) at tea.texas.gov then click on ECOS for Educators at the top of the main page to start creating your Texas Education Agency (TEA) number.

<input type="checkbox"/>	Complete and submit your Educator Preparation Program (EPP) Student Information Application Form and transcript to office 204.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Submission of ALL Official Transcripts from all colleges attended or a transcript from Texas Southern University reflecting transfer courses and “work in progress for current semester”.
