## CAMPUS CRIME ALERT

### UPDATE!

**SUSPECTS ARRESTED:** TSU Police have arrested three (3) suspects in possession of a stolen flat screen television, that is identified as property of Texas Southern University. This is an ongoing investigation, in which there are other persons of interest in this case.

**DATE(S):** May 21, 2009 **TIME(S):** 2:34 am

**OFFENSE:** Burglary of a building

**LOCATION:** Martin Luther king building, 3100 Cleburne, Houston Harris County.

Three unidentified black male suspects entered through the east sliding doors of the Martin Luther King building with forced entry.

Once the suspects entered the building, they forcibly removed two flat screen televisions from the wall mount and escaped in an unknown direction of travel.

**The suspects are described as follows:**

- Black male, age unknown
- Wearing black baseball cap, black hooded sweater, orange gloves, light colored pants and black shoes.

**The second suspect was described as follows:**

- Black male, age unknown
- Wearing a black hooded sweat shirt, light colored pants and black shoes.

**The third suspect was described as follows:**

- Black male, age unknown
- Wearing a light colored hooded sweat shirt with a black shirt a baseball cap and a black shirt underneath, and light colored pants

**SAFETY TIPS:**

Confrontations can occur without provocation, through no fault of your own. When such confrontations do occur, there are some actions you can take.

- **BE ALERT!! Be Cautious of your surroundings.**
- Do not walk alone during late night/early morning hours.
- Be aware of suspicious person(s) and/or irregular behavior.
- Remain as calm as possible. This will not be easy if you are confronted, but it is your first step towards an escape. Your own initiative and clear thinking are your best defenses.
- Report the incident. Call the police immediately and report what has happened. If you call from an "on-campus" land-line telephone, dial 7000. If you are calling from an "off-campus" or cell phone, dial (713)313-7000 or 911.
- Try to notice details. This can allow you to provide the police with detailed physical and clothing descriptions of the person(s) involved.
- If a vehicle is involved, try to note the vehicle's license plate number or the vehicle's manufacturer, model and color or any other identifying features.
