Texas Southern University is located near the heart of downtown Houston and offers programs in eight colleges and schools, College of Liberal Arts, and Behavioral Sciences, College of Pharmacy & Health Sciences, College of Education, Jesse H. Jones School of Business, College of Science and Technology, Thurgood Marshall School of Law, Graduate School, and The College of Continuing Education (COCE). The Southern Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools (SACS) accredits the University.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

4. A non-refundable \$78.00 application fee (international money order or cashier's check drawn on a United States bank). Also, a fee of \$50.00 exists for I-20 renewals.
5. Students must be high school graduates or G.E.D recipients.

FEES*
