Our mission is to prepare counselors, who value equity and equality, to meet the demands of a culturally and linguistically diverse clientele through a special emphasis on knowledge bases and internships in an urban setting.

Goal 1

The goal for the Ed.D, Counselor Education program is to adequately prepare candidates who are competent in counselor education.

Outcome 1.1

Candidates will demonstrate knowledge of the content in counseling the adolescent, individual appraisal in guidance, principles and foundations of guidance, counseling and individual casework, supervised counseling, vocational assessment, college student personnel, and research in counseling. The target is 70% passage rate of the Doctoral Comprehensive Examination.

Findings (2007-2009)

The Department of Counseling had a 100% (n=2) passage rate on the Doctoral Comprehensive Examination for the 2007-2008 academic year. A student is eligible to take the test once they have completed 48 semester credit hours of the 60 required semester credit hours required to complete the program. Although the passage rate is 100%, faculty members recommend that all students taking the Doctoral Comprehensive Examination develop an individual plan of study.

Finding (2009-2010)

The Department of Counseling had a 82% (n=2) passage rate on the Doctoral Comprehensive Examination for the 2009-2010 academic year.

Action Plan Summary – 2008-2009

The Department of Counseling continues to monitor the passage rate of doctoral students on the Doctoral Comprehensive Examination. Data from the comprehensive examination is reviewed with respect to the ongoing program evaluation process.

Action Plan Summary – 2009-2010

Based on 2009-2010 findings the department (1) monitored applications to take the Doctoral Comprehensive exams to be sure candidates had completed all required coursework in Counselor Education. 2) offered more intensive review sessions, particularly for candidates who had completed coursework in Counselor Education.
