**TSU Students:**

The recently enacted federal [CARES Act: Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund](#) provides money to college and universities for emergency student grants. The purpose of the money is to award emergency funding to students for specific expenses that are a direct result of the disruption of campus operations due to the coronavirus/COVID-19.

Beginning on Monday, May 4, all Texas Southern University students who meet the following eligibility requirements will be able to apply for CARES Act emergency aid via an application form that will be posted within the MyTSU portal.

**Eligible students must:**

- Have a completed FAFSA on file.
- Meet the minimum satisfactory academic progress requirement
- Have been enrolled as of March 11, 2020
- Be eligible to participate in Title IV aid programs for financial aid.
- Be a degree-seeking, full-time or part-time student
- Not be enrolled in a program solely offered online.

Eligible students will receive \$850. We will send you additional information with more details later this week, and we will post this information in the MyTSU message center as well as the TSU website, in advance of the May 4, 2020, application launch.
