## Public Affairs Professor Publishes Work



**Jeffrey S. Lowe, Ph.D.**, associate professor of Urban Planning and Environmental Policy in the Barbara Jordan-Mickey Leland School of Public Affairs, recently completed a working paper (co-authored with Emily Thaden) that was published by the Lincoln Institute of Land Policy. Lincoln is the leading resource/think tank for key issues concerning the use, regulation, and taxation of land.

## New Scholarship Formed

**Elwaine K. Johnson** recently donated ten thousand dollars to Texas Southern University for purposes of establishing an endowment for the Elwaine K. Johnson scholarship. The donation was discussed during last month's 2014 Texas Southern University National Alumni Association Convention in Dallas, Texas. The University matches new scholarship endowments one-to-one so Johnson's donation will become \$20,000, if matched by Raytheon. TSU will also match that contribution, turning \$10,000 into \$40,000.

## TSU Students Held Rally Against Injustice

At least two dozen TSU students marched in solidarity August 18 with those in Ferguson, Missouri.

The students and their friends met at the Shrine of the Black Madonna and then chanted their way up Martin Luther King Boulevard to the statue of the slain civil rights leader in MacGregor Park.

They say the death of an unarmed Michael Brown by a law enforcement officer highlights just one of many dangers young African Americans face in their own neighborhoods every day.

Gabrielle Clark, a law student at TSU, said, "Dr. Martin Luther King was correct when he said that injustice anywhere is injustice everywhere. And we're going to take a stand and let our voices be heard."

The students say this is a critical time in our region and country and that the lives of young African-Americans are not valued, their voices not heard.

They say they must engage other young African Americans to help foster the building blocks of a solution. They want to work constructively to find a solution to the problem and turn their actions into justice.
