TSU Office of Veterans Affairs Host “Salute to Heroes” Event

On September 11, 2013, in support of Public Law 107-89 and Public Law 111-13, the **TSU Veterans Task Force, TSU Student Veterans of America**, other institutions, the community, Veterans and their dependents, came together to honor the men and women who lost their lives and those who have since defended our nation from the terrorist attacks beginning at 8:46 a.m., EST September 11, 2001.

The first event was held at TSU's main flagpole between Lanier West and the Nabrit Science Bldg. at 7:30 a.m. The program consisted of the reading of the official Presidential Proclamation from President Barak Obama starting at 7:30 a.m. followed by the National Moment of Silence at 7:46 a.m. The conclusion offered an opportunity for Veterans to meet and an opportunity to allow guests to thank our student vet population for this special day. A Resource Fair was held in room 207 of the Student Center from 11 a.m. to 12 p.m. to allow veterans to receive resource information from various community partners.

The 3rd annual Veterans Week and 9th Annual Veterans Day Program will be held November 11 - 15, recognizing all veterans and dependents. A location has not been determined.
