SUBJECT: TSU Regents finalize Presidential Search Committee

Texas Southern University's Board of Regents, led by Chairman Albert H. Myres, has begun the selection process to determine who will be the University's next president. The Presidential Search Committee, appointed by Chairman Myres, will be led by Regent Marc C. Carter. AGB Search, a higher-education executive search firm based in Washington, DC, has been recommended to assist in facilitating the process.

"Texas Southern University has maintained a position of excellence and resilience in spite of last year's challenges. We have remained focused on our mission and are ready to build on a host of successes to set the next chapter in TSU's history," Chairman Myres said.
