President's Leadership College-Bound Fund Scholarship

The Department of Music at Texas Southern University and Music Doing Good, INC. are collaborating to offer two Undergraduate Scholarships for prospective talent in the field of music performance or music education. Our goal is to encourage the pursuit of music as a profession and provide financial assistance to qualifying applicants in the **Greater Houston area** interested in completing a music degree at Texas Southern University.

Scholarships are currently available to high-school seniors who will become full-time freshmen in the fall of 2019 OR transfer students. Students must show exceptional music and academic ability and *must* be admitted to Texas Southern University in order to be selected.

The scholarship funds can be used to cover expenses for tuition, institutional living expenses, books, fees, and/or supplies for the fall and/or spring semesters. Funds will be equally distributed in \$5000 amounts for each semester and will not exceed eight semesters or four years.

Recipients must:

- Be present at the Music Doing Good Scholarship presentation in the fall of 2019.
- Sign a media release allowing Music Doing Good to use their likeness and biographical information in newsletters, press releases, and event programs.
- Perform at one Music Doing Good fundraising event annually

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 1. Applicants must meet all requirements for regular admission to Texas Southern University.
- 2. Applicants who reside in the U.S. must be legal residents, have been granted permanent residency, or have a valid visa that does not prohibit educational studies.
- 3. Applicants must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form or the Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA) if international student
