EXPLANATION OF NOTES:

NOTE*** - **Does Not** Meet Writing Requirement.

NOTE 1 - Required course - must be taken this semester.

NOTE 2 - Required course - MAY be taken in either the second or third year.

NOTE 2a- Rising 2Ls cannot take Basic Federal Taxation and Consumer Rights in the same semester!!!!!!

NOTE 2a(1) Rising 2Ls with GPA Below 3.0 cannot take electives!!!

NOTE 2b - Third year required course if GPA is < (less than) 3.0.

NOTE 3 - Meets the writing Requirement - maximum enrollment - 20 per class.

NOTE 4 - Electives may be taken in second year(if GPA above 3.0) or third year .

NOTE 5 - Prior approval is necessary see Director of Legal Clinic.

NOTE6 - Minimum GPA requirement is **2.5**. THIRD YEAR STUDENTS ONLY!

NOTE 7 - Registration by application and permission. At registration, student must submit an approved application and outline. Get form from Dean Mouton's office. *

Dean Mouton coordinates the administrative portion. Each faculty member may supervise ONLY one student's research per semester (one student - one project).

NOTE 8 - Prior approval is necessary - See Professor Douglas for details.

NOTE 9 - Mandatory class to be taken in the Fall or Spring Semester.

NOTE 10 - Student can enroll in ONLY one (1) 804/805 class per semester.

NOTE 11 - Each 2L student must be registered in a minimum of 11 hours of required 2L courses.

NOTE 12 - A Clean Record is Required (criminal)

NOTE 13 - Non-Credit Enhancement Course in house registration at the Law School through Ijeoma Opara, Director, Academic Support

NOTE 14- MUST BE TAKEN IN CONJUNCTION WITH (AT THE SAME TIME AS) CRIMINAL TRIAL PRACTICE, CIVIL TRIAL PRACTICE OR ADMINISTRATIVE TRIAL PRACTICE

NOTE 15- Strongly encouraged to take appropriate content related course.

NOTE 16- Seminars & Clinics can not be dropped after 1st day of class.

NOTE 17- 3Ls only
