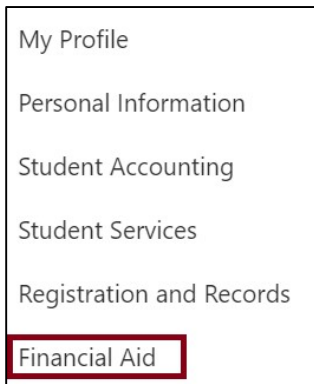

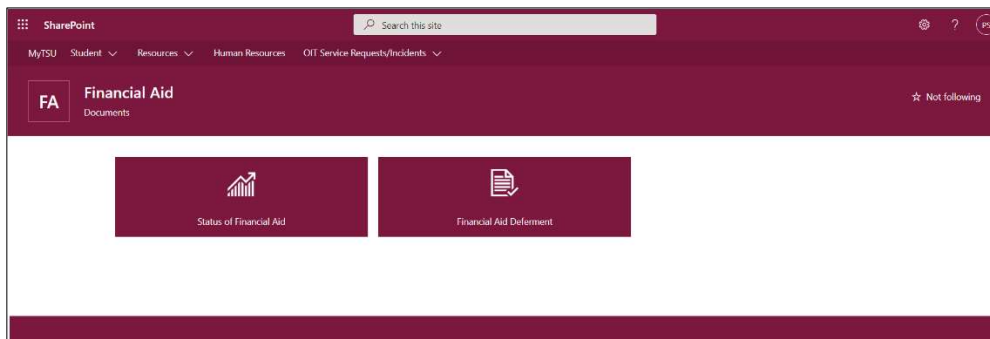
1. Navigate to MyTSU portal landing page click, 'Student'



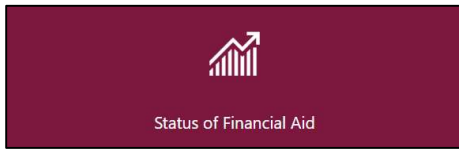
2. Choose "Financial Aid"



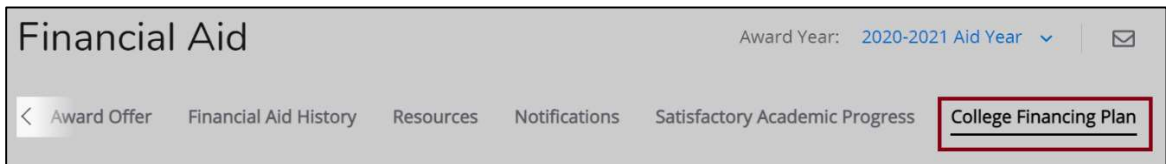
Two (2) intuitive and adaptive tiles (shortcuts) will display, but with sub-menus.
