#### **OVERVIEW**

The Online Executive Master of Public Administration (eMPA) Program has a currciulum uniquely designed to meet the growing demand for mid-career professionals in the public sector who wish to pursue an Executive MPA degree. The program is conveniently offered online and provides a focus on public policy. The eMPA Program combines the advanced skill concepts of a Master of Public Administration program and prepares administrators to lead and manage organizations.

Upon completion of the eMPA Program, graduates will:

- Demonstrate a balanced inventory of conceptual, quantitative and professional skills.


#### PROGRAM STRUCTURE
