Semester Credit Hours x Program/Level Weight x Rate

Teaching Experience Supplement provides an extra 10%

2,752 Lower Division Students x 3 semester credit hours (3) = 8,256 SCH

Formula Funding Funds Generated:

8,256 SCH x 1 (weight) x \$55.82 (rate) = \$460,849

Teaching Experience Supplement:

8,256 SCH x 1 (weight) x 0.10 (supplement) x \$55.82 (rate) = \$46,085

Total Funds Lower Division: \$460,849 + \$46,085 = \$506,933

359 Upper Division Students x 3 SCH = 1,077 SCH

Formula Funding Funds Generated:

1,077 SCH x 1.73 (weight) x \$55.82 (rate) = \$104,004

Teaching Experience Supplement:

1,077 SCH x 1.73 (weight) x 0.10 (supplement) x \$55.82 (rate) = \$6,011

Total Funds Upper Division: \$104,004 + \$6,011 = \$110,015

Total Funds Generated: \$506,933 + \$110,015 = \$616,948
