## Superintendent Certification Requirements

There are five requirements to obtain a Superintendent certificate.

- must hold a master's degree from a university that is accredited by an accrediting agency recognized by the <u>Texas Higher</u> Education Coordinating Board (outside source) or a <u>U.S. Department of Education Database for Accredited Colleges and</u> <u>Universities (outside source)</u>
- $\circ$  hold a Principal certificate or the equivalent issued by the TEA, another state or country or,
- completed the <u>superintendent certificate application (PDF, 314 KB)</u> and been approved by the TEA to substitute managerial experience in lieu of a principal certificate
- o successfully complete an approved superintendent educator preparation program
- o successfully complete the required examination
