## **ELIGIBITY**

# \*Students who have applied to the university\*

Students who do not intend to attend Texas Southern University <u>must not</u> take the ACT-R testing on campus. Registration must take place through the <u>National ACT Registration</u> <u>site</u> and will be subject to pre-scheduled testing dates and times.

## **TEST DATES**

- ➤ The ACT-R testing dates are scheduled through the Testing Center by appointment.
- > Scheduling availability will vary per examinee, date, time and availability.
- ➤ The 2017-2018 ACT Residual Testing year runs through September 30, 2019.
- > Dates will be updated each month on the testing website for scheduling purposes.

# **SCORES**

- > Scores from residual testing are **only** valid at Texas Southern University. The scores are non-transferable to other institutions and/or agencies.
- > Scores from the ACT-Residual testing are reported to the Texas Southern University Academic College or School of the major listed on your admissions file.
- ➤ Additional score reports are not generated and/or reported to any other institution or agency.

#### RESTRICTIONS

- A minimum of 60 days must elapse before another ACT-R test may be taken.
- > Scores achieved before the minimum elapsed time will be cancelled without refund.
- > ACT restricts the number of times a student may take the ACT to 12 times total.
- > ACT-R testing does count toward that maximum.
- > Scores that exceed the maximum will be canceled without refund.

**Time Duration:** The ACT-R is a standardized exam that is timed for 3 ½ hours.

<u>Test Results</u>: Scores will be sent to the Office of Admissions within 5 days of your test date. Copies of scores are not provided to examinees.

**Rescheduled Exams:** Please contact the Testing Center to reschedule your test date and time.

**Retesting:** Examinees must wait <u>60 days</u> before an exam retake.



## **IMPORTANT TESTING INFORMATION**

**What to Bring:** A government issued; unexpired ID with a recognizable photograph and signature, such as a driver's license, state ID, and/or passport. High school students *only* may use a current high school photo ID.

<u>Special Instructions (Calculator Policy)</u>: It is the examinee's responsibility to provide his/her own calculator and know whether if the calculator is permissible. For the most current information on the ACT calculator policy, please visit <u>www.actstudent.org</u>.

**ACT-R Study Information**: The **ACT-R Study Guide** offers sample ACT tests available in each National ACT registration packet.

**Security:** For security purposes, metal scanning and detection will be conducted before entering the testing room(s), per testing center policies and procedures.
